

Safety and Security Committee meeting
July 13, 2023

8:00 Meeting called to order by Bridgett Blake

Those committee members unable to attend: Greg Venneman, Mike Finney, Nicholas Hartzler, Kevin Meyer, and Steve Butz,

Steve Rand made a motion to approve the June 8, 23 meeting minutes and a second was made by Joshua Johnson. NOTE: Following our meeting a text was sent by Nicholas Hartzler correcting the name of the security company as named in the June 8th minutes. Instead of “Corby Security has been approved by the SBD board” the correction on those minutes was changed to “Campbell Security Group has been approved by the SBD board.” Please submit this revision to the website.” This is important as we need to have no question as to who we have contracted with.

Much of our meeting focused on a document handed out in regard to Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ). A good number of suggestions were made and Chris Street noted those and will revise the document for all to see before final approval. Once finalized the document will be added to the SBD website. Also the social media site, Nextdoor, will be used to contact Holly Hills residents on the means to access the FAQ document.

A question was raised as to when Campbell Security Group will attend our meetings. It was suggested that they have an appearance at our September, December, March, and June meetings. Our communication liaison with them is Nicholas Hartzler and he would be the person to arrange this if possible. We can then let the public know of when they would be at meetings should they want to attend for those meetings.

Our Court liaison, Bob Dowd, will call Pierre Benoist of Campbell Security Group to discuss that topic. If he needs to he has a contact with the Court he can communicate with.

While our funds as the Safety and Security Committee are dedicated to patrols we could combine with the Infrastructure Committee on other things. An idea that someone is interested in is traffic safety as a possibility.
