

12-14-2023 Safety and Security Committee meeting

Nicholas Hartzler made a motion to approve the November meeting minutes and this was seconded by Bob Dowd.

Nicholas Hartzler said the inbox for comments regarding Campbell Security is available. This will be put on the SBD website.

Dennis Chandler sent out mapping GPS coordinates. This will show security coverage. GPS sends a location every 30 seconds and it would be helpful to increase that frequency. An increase will answer questions residents may have about coverage.

Chris Saracino who was present at the meeting for Campbell Security said the Google forms for Officers to complete are helpful. Chris said they are averaging 6 to 7 shifts per week with a goal to get to 10. He said GPS data starts when officers leave the station. Chris said when residents call 911 the Campbell Officers on duty hear it. He said calls to 911 are having a faster response. He also said it is important to note that when residents call 911 a record is created.

At the January 11, 2024 Safety and Security meeting Circuit Attorney will be present along with staff. The meeting will be a town hall format. We have hosting this meeting.

Bob Dowd reported the defendant, Robert Downing, is facing charges from two incidents that occurred on August 14 and August 15. A public defender has been appointed. Mr. Downing's next scheduled Court dates December 19th.
