**SBD Signage and Branding Committee -**

**Mural:**

Plans are moving forward to paint the side of the building on Bates by the railroad tracks. The owner has been notified and is cooperating with the plans for the mural.

**Raised Bed Planters:**

Raised planter beds are completed and discussion followed regarding plants and signage for the beds. The discussion ended with no conclusion as to when to plant or when signage will be available. The possibility of small signs basically saying watch this spot in spring was discussed.

**Brush Removal and Tree Planting:**

Discussion about plant removal on Bellerive parkways and installation of raised plans for raised planter beds. Monica gave an update on trees on Bates. Some need trimming, some need removal and new trees need to be planted. Monica will continue to work on this. Invasive plant removal in Carondelet Park discussed again.

**Other Business -**

Brooks gave some estimates on the cost of upcoming projects and money available in 2025. This is an ongoing process. Nancy Nafe was introduced as a potential member of the Beautification Committee. The SBD board will decide on a new member as outlined in the rules.
