Bob Dowd made a motion to approve the 2-13-25 meeting minutes and it was seconded by Eileen O'Sullivan. The members voted to approve the minutes

The RFP for the second round for security services went out on February 22nd, 2025. There have been questions from two security firms. There are no bids yet. Questions from firms can be submitted until March 31st. The RFP period is open for bids until April 15, 2025. Eight security firms were contacted and we are likely to receive three bids.

There was a car clotting (car windows broken) on March 4th, 2025, on Toeges. Our security company increased late night patrols and two nights later they spotted a yellow Dodge Charger on Wilmington at Livingston and it seemed the occupants were about to do damage when they spotted the security patrol and sped off. The security patrol notified our police department.

Bob Dowd made a report in regard to a father and son team that broke into a garage on December 9, 2024 in the 3900 block of Wilmington. Items valued at up to \$3,000 were stolen. The son was apprehended and there was a search warrant issued for his residence. The father and son team were found to be part of a 2.6 million dollar theft ring. Their home is in the 7800 hundred block of Minnesota. The son is facing 27 counts of theft. The father fled and is not presently in custody.

In view of the RFP not expiring until April 15th we agreed it would be better to instead of meeting on the second Thursday of April to have the meeting on Thursday, April 17, 2025 when we can discuss the RFP bids.
