Meeting was called to order at 6:54 PM by Angie Butz.

Minutes from Feb. 3rd, 2025 meeting approved.

Overview: As a committee we reviewed the Federer plan and survey details, discussed the Focal Pointe contract update, updates on the entry markers and light pole banners, additional seating and hedgehog sculptures, planters, murals and the community garden.

Landscape Committee -

Focal Pointe Contract Update:

- Pursued the bid from Focal Pointe due to them being least expensive and having good testimonies.
- Lily Horstmeyer is our main contact.
- Starting installation est. middle April (between April 15th after last frost - April 30th).
- Watering maintenance starting twice per week as needed.

Bellerive:

- removal of older flower beds complete
- plants were repurposed within the neighborhood, and for sale to the community outside the neighborhood.

Tree Trimming:

- Monica volunteered to create a write-up for our newsletter that educates the community on how to use the online service request feature through the city to help maintain our trees/and other other maintenance or emergency situations.
- ongoing conversation on how to properly allocate some funding towards specific maintenance that would benefit the safety and beautification of our neighborhood community spaces.

Branding Committee -

Federer Plan:

- survey results completed
- most residents that came to the board meeting expressed opinions of not adding any additional materials or features to the Federer greenspace, however the filled out survey card expressed that some residents were more open to ideas.
- starting our focus with making sure the grass-areas are maintained and adding some picnic tables to the area.

Hedgehogs:

- Names are in! Jenny and Irene spearheaded the hedgehog coloring contest.
- 2 winners were chosen with 3 honorable mentions
- Our final Hedgehog names will be Holly, Harry, Cosmo and Alma!

Entry Markers and Banners:

- Excel Signs making 14 additional light pole banners
- waiting on Ten8 for final entry marker artwork. Est. to be installed and fabricated in the 1st 2 weeks of April.
- planting for the raised beds can begin once entry markers are installed.
- For those who are interested, light pole banners can be purchased for individual purchase through Excel Signs.

Murals:

- waiting on weather to dry/warm up to continue work on the Bates/RR area mural
- Infrastructure committee is paying for mural that will be on Loughborough, near Morganford.

Community Garden:

- was noted that if we wanted to re-visualize the garden into an area that includes garden beds and also a light playscape/nature learning area, that it wouldn't increase any liability for insurance.
- discussions are taking place on how to make this space more useful to the community.

Planter:

- Need to rehome the planter on the round-about near the Lyle House as it has been moved from the center/hit too many times. Discussions are taking place to decide the best location.
