Agenda Items:

- **Approval of December Meeting Minutes:**
 - Jarred will email additions tomorrow.
- **Outreach:**
 - Committee to decide if a single member will manage outreach or if the committee will share responsibility
- **Speed Hump Installation:**
 - All proposed speed humps have been installed
 - Committee received a speed hump request from a resident.
 - Daniel suggested helping residents with a FAQ and possible resources pertaining to neighborhood infrastructure issues. Brett and Meghan will explore this idea.
- **Speed Hump Painting:**
 - Brett has not heard back from Ten8 on design services as of the meeting
- **Crosswalk Painting:**
 - Brett found an outdated estimate to paint all neighborhood crosswalks that totaled \$50,000
 - Brett will continue to work with Brooks on the permitting process
- **Holly Hills & Leona Intersection:**
 - A meeting was held with Brooks to discuss the intersection.
 - There is some confusion as to which of the multiple TrailNet options would be utilized and some concerns about the aesthetics of the materials and products that will be proposed.

- A resident asked about options and did not want a roundabout which we assured him was not in our current plans/drawings.
- Proposing a community meeting that would share an updated plan and 3D rendering of the proposed intersection.

Ryan motioned to engage Goetz Group to create 3D rendering and presentation drawings of the proposed intersection at a cost of no more than \$3500.00:
